# PRESENTING THIS MONTH: ERIC OSZUSTOWICZ

The February meeting of the Electric Railroaders' Association will be held on Friday, February 17, 2012 at the St. John's University Manhattan Campus building, at 101 Murray Street, between Greenwich and West Streets, in downtown Manhattan. The University is a three block walk [1-1/2 blocks south and 1-1/2 blocks west] from the Chambers Street station of the West Side IRT Subway. The doors open at 6:15 PM, and the meeting commences at 7:15 PM. Bring your 2011 or 2012 membership card with you for admission. THE DOOR FEE FOR NON-MEMBERS IS \$5.00. #### **PROGRAM**

The February program will be presented by Eric Oszustowicz. His slide program will encompass highly unusual and diverse subject matter, most of which has never been seen at any of our programs.

The highlight of the presentation will be the photographic results of Eric's trip to India in 2011. We will see extensive coverage of India's only streetcar line in Kolkata (Calcutta). In many ways, this streetcar system is one of the most unique systems on the planet. We will also see the extraordinary electric MU commuter operations in Mumbai (Bombay) and Kolkata, which operate crowded high speed trains with its doors wide open while moving. Eric also visited Bengaluru (Bangalore). In all three cities, views of the intercity services of the massive Indian Railways system will be included. Some bus services will also be covered.

Eric also traveled to Utah this past October. In 2011, the light rail system in Salt Lake City opened two new extensions and received delivery of 77 new light rail vehicles. We will see views of the light rail system, which has become very photogenic, in addition to some coverage of the commuter rail system. While in Utah, Eric also photographed the spectacular freight line over Soldier Summit. Of course we will see these photographs.

Also in 2011, Eric travelled to Edmonton, where he photographed the newest extension into south Edmonton together with the new vehicles purchased to expand their system. We will also see the newest cars operating on the Calgary LRT system.

Please join us for an interesting evening of unusual and new subject matter.
