


Pennsylvania Weekend

Saturday and Sunday, October 24–25, 2015



Join the ERA in our visit to Pennsylvania's Railroad Havens

The ERA is pleased to announce our Pennsylvania Weekend trip. Conventions not included, this is our first two-day trip since 2011 and we expect it to be one to remember. We will visit the Strasburg Rail Road, the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania, the Steamtown Historic Site and the Electric City Trolley Museum.

We leave from NYC at 8:00 a.m. from the east side of 8th Avenue, just south of West 41st Street, across the street from the Port Authority Bus Terminal. From there, we begin our fun with a visit to the Strasburg Rail Road in time for a quick lunch followed by a 45-minute train ride through Amish Country. We will then visit the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania in Strasburg. This museum covers more than 18 acres and houses over 100 historic locomotives and railroad cars that chronicle American Railroad History — the core of their collection was originally part of the Pennsylvania Railroad's 1939 World's Fair exhibit. We conclude our day with an all-you-can-eat Pennsylvania Dutch buffet at Shady Maple in Lancaster and a stay at the Quality Inn in Wilks-Barre, including a free hot breakfast the next morning.

Our next day begins at 8:30 a.m. with a short trip to the Electric City Trolley Museum in Scranton and a long ride in a former Red Arrow streetcar/interurban from the museum to the Scranton Baseball Park. Following time for lunch in Scranton we will visit the Steamtown National Historic site, a railroad museum and heritage railroad in Scranton, Pennsylvania, located on the former yards of the Delaware, Lackawanna and Western Railroad. Their museum features original DL&W buildings, steam locomotives and other equipment and has been continually expanded since their origins as a private collection. We expect to be back in New York City before 7:00 p.m. so that there will be no need for a dinner stop on the way.

Ticket Price: \$195 Per Person double occupancy. For single occupancy the price is \$260 per person.
